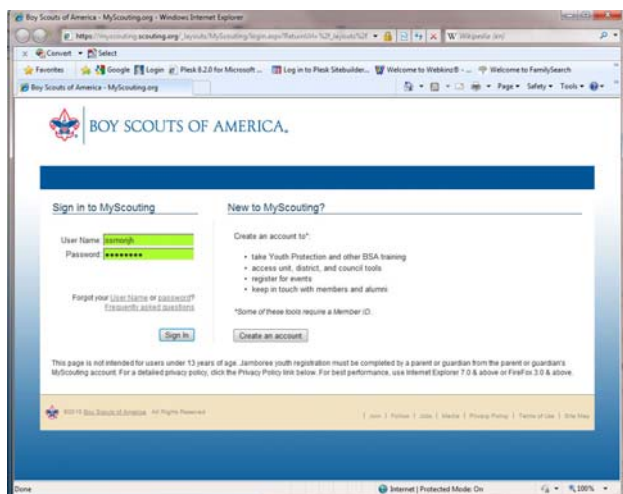


LDS Scout Leader Required Training Made Easy (2010)

Cub Scout Leaders

Most of the training for a Scout Leader is online. First you need to register. Go to www.Scouting.org then click on **Training** in the top Menu. You can sign in or create a new account by selecting the option in the top right hand corner of the page. You will need your unique Member ID that was assigned to you the first time you registered as an Adult Scout Leader. Contact your unit leadership or call the Council at 847-833-1813 and ask them for your Member ID so you can complete online training.



All Cub Scout Leaders must complete the following three online courses to be fully trained:

IMPORTANT: To document that you completed the training, send an e-mail to **Felicia Brandt, Council Training Chairman**, at felicia_brandt@adp.com. In addition to sending your name, please indicate the Council, District, Unit Number, Chartering Organization, and Community where the Pack is located. After you complete all three required courses, you will receive a patch indicating you are a Trained Leader.
